HCPCS CODES	HCPCS CODE DESCRIPTIONS	COMMENTS
L7510	Repair of prosthetic device, repair or replace minor parts	This code covers replacement parts for bone anchored hearing aid that are not otherwise classified by another HCPCS code; bill Part B
L7520	Repair prosthetic device, labor component, per 15 minutes	This code covers the labor for repair of cochlear implant or bone anchored hearing aid; bill Part B
L8614	Cochlear device, includes all internal and external components	This code represents the acquisition/device cost of an initial cochlear implant, speech processor and accessory kit; billed by implanting facility
L8615	Headset/headpiece for use with cochlear implant device, replacement	This is to be used when providing a replacement headset/headpiece or any component of those items to a cochlear implant recipient; this is not to be used to bill an initial device fitting; bill Part B
L8616	Microphone for use with cochlear implant device, replacement	This is to be used when providing a replacement microphone or any component of those items to a cochlear implant recipient; this is not to be used to bill an initial device fitting; bill Part B
L8617	Transmitting coil for use with cochlear implant device, replacement	This is to be used when providing a replacement transmitting coil or any component of those items to a cochlear implant recipient; this is not to be used to bill an initial device fitting; bill Part B
L8618	Transmitter cable for use with cochlear implant device, replacement	This is to be used when providing a replacement transmitter cable to a cochlear implant recipient; this is not to be used to bill an initial device fitting; bill Part B
L8619	Cochlear implant, external speech processor and controller, integrated system, replacement	This code covers the acquisition/device cost of a replacement or upgraded integrated speech processor/controller for use with a cochlear implant; bill Part B
L8621	Zinc air battery for use with cochlear implant device, replacement, each	This code is used to bill for replacement batteries for a cochlear implant; this is billed per battery so it must be multiplied; bill Part B
L8622	Alkaline battery for use with cochlear implant device, any size, replacement, each	This code is used to bill for replacement batteries for a cochlear implant; this is billed per battery so it must be multiplied; bill Part B
L8623	Lithium ion battery for use with cochlear implant device speech processor, other than ear level, replacement, each	This code is used to bill for replacement batteries for a cochlear implant; this is billed per battery so it must be

		multiplied; bill Part B
L8624	Lithium ion battery for use with cochlear implant device speech processor, ear level, replacement, each	This code is used to bill for replacement batteries for a cochlear implant; this is billed per battery so it must be multiplied; bill Part B
L8627	Cochlear implant, external speech processor, component, replacement	This code covers the acquisition/device cost of a replacement or upgraded speech processor for use with a cochlear implant; bill Part B
L8628	Cochlear implant, external controller component, replacement	This code covers the acquisition/device cost of a replacement or upgraded controller for use with a cochlear implant; bill Part B
L8629	Transmitting coil and cable, integrated for use with cochlear implant device, replacement	This is to be used when providing a replacement an integrated transmitting coil and cable to a cochlear implant recipient; this is not to be used to bill an initial device fitting; bill Part B
L8690	Auditory osseointegrated device, includes all internal and external components	This code is used to bill a bone anchored hearing aid system; billed by implanting facility
L8691	Auditory osseointegrated device, external sound processor, replacement	This code is used to bill a replacement, bone anchored hearing aid, external sound processor; bill Part B
L8692	Auditory osseointegrated device, external sound processor, used without osseointegration, body worn, includes headband or other mean of external attachment	This code is for a bone anchored hearing aid that is not implanted but rather worn with a soft band; bill Part B
L8693	Auditory osseointegrated device abutment, any length, replacement only	This is a code for a replacement abutment; this should be billed by implanting facility
L9900	Orthotic and prosthetic supply, accessory and/or service component of another HCPCS "L" code	As this is an "unlisted service", this code can be used to represent items or services related to a cochlear implant or a bone anchored hearing aid that are not otherwise classified; this could include, but is not limited to, bone anchored hearing aid batteries, bone anchored hearing aid fitting and programming and cochlear implant and bone anchored hearing aid troubleshooting; bill Part B
S0618	Audiometry for hearing aid evaluation to determine level and degree of hearing loss	This code can be used for hearing testing solely related to ordering and fitting a hearing aid; please consult payer agreements prior to use as not all agreements allow for the use of this code; cannot be billed to Medicare or Medicaid
S1001	Deluxe item, patient aware (list in addition to code for basic item)	This code can be used to represent an upgraded hearing aid; please consult payer agreements prior to use as not all agreements allow for the use of this code
V5008	Hearing screening	This code represents a pass/fail hearing screening; same as CPT code 92551
V5010	Assessment for hearing aid	This code represents a hearing aid

		examination and selection/consultation; same as CPT codes 92590- 92591
V5011	Fitting/orientation/checking of hearing aid	This code represents a hearing aid fitting; can also be used for a follow-up hearing aid check if on a separate date of service
V5014	Repair/modification of a hearing aid	This code covers either monaural or binaural in-house or manufacturers repairs, re-programming, and shell modifications or remakes
V5020	Conformity Evaluation	This code includes real-ear, functional gain, and outcome measures; verification
V5030	Hearing aid, monaural body worn, air conduction	Monaural, air conduction body aid
V5040	Hearing aid, monaural body worn, bone conduction	Monaural, bone conduction body aid
V5050	Hearing aid, monaural, in-the-ear	Monaural, full shell or low profile hearing aid
V5060	Hearing aid, monaural, behind-the-ear	Monaural, behind-the-ear hearing aid
V5070	Glasses, air conduction	Monaural, air conduction hearing aid contained in a pair of glasses
V5080	Glasses, bone conduction	Monaural, bone conduction hearing aid contained in a pair of glasses
V5090	Dispensing fee, unspecified hearing aid	This code represents the provider's dispensing fee of an unspecified hearing aid (i.e. deep insertion/subscription device, combo masker/aid) when the insurer requests an unbundled cost package
V5095	Semi-implantable middle-ear hearing prosthesis	This code represents the acquisition/device cost of an implantable hearing aid
V5100	Hearing aid, bilateral, body worn	Binaural, air or bone conduction body aid
V5110	Dispensing fee, bilateral	This code represents the provider's dispensing fee of a binaural glasses or body aid fitting, a binaural disposable, analog, digitally programmable or digital hearing aid fitting when the insurer requests an unbundled cost package; same as code V5160
V5130	Binaural, in-the-ear	Binaural, full shell or low profile hearing aid
V5140	Binaural, behind-the-ear	Binaural, behind-the-ear hearing aid
V5150	Binaural, glasses	Binaural, air or bone conduction hearing aid contained in a pair of glasses
V5160	Dispensing fee, binaural	This code represents a provider's dispensing fee of a binaural glasses or body aid fitting, a binaural disposable, analog, digitally programmable or digital hearing aid fitting when the insurer requests an unbundled cost package; same as code V5110
V5170	Hearing aid, CROS, in-the-ear	In-the-ear CROS system (includes both the receiver and the transmitter)
V5180	Hearing aid, CROS, behind-the-ear	Behind-the-ear CROS system (includes both the receiver and the transmitter)

V5190	Hearing aid, CROS, glasses	CROS system that is contained in pair of eyeglasses
V5200	Dispensing fee, CROS	This code represents a provider's dispensing fee any CROS fitting when the insurer requests an unbundled cost package
V5210	Hearing aid, BICROS, in-the-ear	In-the-ear BICROS system (includes both the transmitter and the hearing aid/receiver)
V5220	Hearing aid, BICROS, behind-the-ear	Behind-the-ear BICROS system (includes both the transmitter and the hearing aid/receiver)
V5230	Hearing aid, BICROS, glasses	BICROS system that is contained in pair of eyeglasses
V5200	Dispensing fee, BICROS	This code represents a provider's dispensing fee any BICROS fitting when the insurer requests an unbundled cost package
V5241	Dispensing fee, monaural, any type	This code represents a provider's dispensing fee of any monaural hearing aid fitting, including a body aid, glasses, disposable, analog, digitally programmable or digital hearing aid when the insurer requests an unbundled cost package
V5242	Hearing aid, analog, monaural, CIC	Monaural, analog, CIC aid
V5243	Hearing aid, analog, monaural, ITC	Monaural, analog, canal, half-shell, or mini canal aid
V5244	Hearing aid, digitally programmable analog, monaural, CIC	Monaural, digitally programmable, analog, CIC aid
V5245	Hearing aid, digitally programmable, analog, monaural, ITC	Monaural, digitally programmable, analog, canal, half-shell, or mini canal aid
V5246	Hearing aid, digitally programmable, analog, monaural, ITE	Monaural, digitally programmable, analog, ITE or Low Profile aid

V5260	Hearing aid, digital, binaural, ITE	Binaural, digital, ITE or Low Profile aids
V5261	Hearing aid, digital, binaural, BTE	Binaural, digital, BTE aids
V5262	Hearing aid, disposable, any type, monaural	Monaural, disposable hearing aid; please make sure to specify number of aids being purchased
V5263	Hearing aid, disposable, any type, binaural	Binaural, disposable hearing aids; please make sure to specify number of aids being purchased
V5264	Earmold/insert, not disposable, any type	Custom earmold/earpiece; this can be used for swim plugs, noise plugs, ear protection, etc.; please make sure to specify number of molds being purchased
V5265	Earmold/insert, disposable, any type	Disposable earmold/earpiece such as a Comply mold, dome, or insert; please make sure to specify number of molds being purchased
V5266	Battery for use in hearing device	Batteries for use in body aids, glasses, hearing aids, cochlear implants, implantable devices, etc.; this is billed per battery so please specify the number of batteries
V5267	Hearing aid or assistive listening device/supplies/accessories, not otherwise specified	Remote controls, dri-aid kits, accessory kits, forced air blowers, cleaning tools, etc.; please specify the number of accessories being billed; this code is also used to represent any FM/DM accessory or supply that is not otherwise listed or captured by another new or existing code; this code is used to represent any FM/DM accessory or supply that is not otherwise listed or captured by another new or existing code.
V5268	Assistive listening device, telephone amplifier, any type	Telephone amplifier, whether it is in-line, portable, an entire phone or a handset; please make sure to specify the number of amplifiers being billed
V5269	Assistive listening device, alerting, any type	Alerting devices such as flashing lights, alarms, clocks, etc.
V5270	Assistive listening device, television amplifier, any type	Headphones, infrared systems, etc. specifically for listening to the television
V5271	Assistive listening device, television caption decoder	Television closed captioning device
V5272	Assistive listening device, TDD	TDD for telephone use
V5273	Assistive listening device, for use with a cochlear implant	FM system, telephone device, beam former, etc. specifically for use with a cochlear implant
V5274	Assistive listening device, not otherwise specified	FM systems, personal amplifiers, etc.
V5275	Ear impression, each	Taking of an earmold impression; please specify one or two units for one or two ears

V5281	Assistive listening device, personal FM/DM system, monaural, (1 receiver, transmitter, microphone), any type	This code is appropriate when fitting an entire monaural system, regardless of the type of receiver or transmitter used. This does not include the boot, as it is coded separately.
V5282	Assistive listening device, personal FM/DM system, binaural, (2 receivers, transmitter, microphone), any type	This code is appropriate when fitting an entire binaural system, regardless of the type of receiver or transmitter used. This does not include the boots, as they are coded separately.
V5283	Assistive listening device, personal FM/DM neck, loop induction receiver	This code is appropriate when dispensing a neck loop receiver in isolation (replacement, extra receiver, etc.) that is coupled with the t-coil of a hearing aid.
V5284	Assistive listening device, personal FM/DM, ear level receiver	This code is appropriate when dispensing an ear level receiver in isolation (replacement, extra receiver, etc.). This code is for an ear-level device for those with normal hearing. The code is per receiver.
V5285	Assistive listening device, personal FM/DM, direct audio input receiver	This code is appropriate when dispensing a direct audio input receiver (the receiver is the cord which connects to the boot) in isolation (replacement, extra receiver, etc.). This does not include the boot, as each is coded separately.
V5286	Assistive listening device, personal blue tooth FM/DM receiver	The code is appropriate when dispensing a streamer in isolation (replacement, extra receiver, etc.).
V5287	Assistive listening device, personal FM/DM receiver, not otherwise specified	This is for any existing or yet to be released receiver that is not represented by another code above.
V5288	Assistive listening device, personal FM/DM transmitter assistive listening device	This code is appropriate when dispensing any type of FM/DM transmitter in isolation (replacement, extra receiver, etc.).
V5289	Assistive listening device, personal FM/DM adapter/boot coupling device for receiver, any type	The code is appropriate for the audio boot dispensed in any situation. This code is per boot. A initial, binaural FM fitting would constitute two boots.
V5290	Assistive listening device, transmitter microphone, any type	This code is appropriate when dispensing any type of FM/DM microphone transmitter in isolation (replacement, extra receiver, etc.).
V5298	Hearing aid, not otherwise specified	Any hearing aid that does not fall into any of the other categories; this could include, but is not limited to, a deep insertion/subscription hearing aid and a combination hearing aid/tinnitus masker
V5299	Hearing service, miscellaneous	Any other item or service, such as an extended warranty, loss and damage deductible, or tinnitus masker that is not otherwise listed
